- 1970's** Harvest Supper was the whole school annual community event - now the Valentines Meal for Senior Citizens in the community. Meals prepared, served by Year 11 students
- 1981** Work Related Learning (WRL) programme begins with partnerships with employers-to build over the coming 30 years into the largest WRL in Jersey
- 1991** Pride of Grainville Awards began in celebration of students showing endeavour and overcoming difficulties to succeed
- 2000** First organisation in Jersey to be awarded Investors in People

 - First school in Jersey to use Kirkland Rowell attitudinal survey to benchmark parental views
 - Poetry slam: Island Champions
 - New school uniform introduced- blazer, shirt, tie, trousers- no skirt
 - Eisteddfod: **92** competitors- school record
 - First Durrell Walk- Grainville is first school to become a corporate partner to Durrell
- 2011**
 - Channel Island First Aid Champions
 - Inaugural cluster carol service involving the Grainville Choir (student & staff) and six primary choirs
 - First school in Jersey to use the Kirkland Rowell attitudinal survey to find out the views of students and staff to school life, benchmarked to 1000 UK schools
 - Year 7 Horizon begins – ‘a school within a school’
 - Grainville awarded St John Ambulance School Mark- first school in Jersey to achieve this status
 - National First Aid Champions
 - Finalist in National Community Award
 - Runner up in Poetry Slam
 - Army Cadet Force Platoon founded – one of only 60 state schools in the UK
 - First ever recipients of the St John Ambulance National Community Award for Schools. Awarded First place over 27,800 schools in the UK
 - Eisteddfod:- 186 students involved - New school record- 1/3 of school. Fantastic achievement with many class winners.
