
Grainville GCSE Results 2023

At Grainville School we set high expectations to **inspire**, **motivate and challenge** our students to achieve the very best they can. We also provide strong pastoral support and guidance so that all students, whatever their outcomes, can move on successfully to the next stage in their learning journey.

We are very proud to have supported the Class of 2023 through their secondary school career, ending with GCSE results that they can be proud of. This group of students have had to negotiate the changing landscape of learning through the pandemic, developing resilience and a range of online and independent learning skills. They were affected by school closures in the second half of their Year 8, and following a return to school, moved quickly into choosing their GCSE options in Year 9.

Over the last 2 years we have seen external examinations evolve as we have moved into the post-Covid era of standards. This year the examination boards sought to return grade boundaries back to 2019 levels, which meant that this cohort did not have the benefit of adjustments afforded to the 2021 and 2022 cohorts. We are proud of our students' achievements and of the staff and parents that have supported these young people.



Students are assigned individual target grades based on their Year 9 CAT4 tests. These are used as benchmarks to encourage students to achieve their potential as well as to compare the overall results of cohorts. Our 2023 results were as expected and in line with CAT generated targets.

English and Maths both exceeded CAT GCSE Targets in 2023

9 subjects exceeded their targets for strong passes at Grade 5 or higher.
Value-added in 16 subjects across the curriculum met or exceeded expectation.
Vocational results in partnership with Highlands College exceeded expectation.
